Opening:

President Bill Allen thanked Frank Ramirez for stepping up to fill the empty Tournament Director position.

Old Business:

1. The Handicap Director updated the Board with the latest CVMC membership. 82 total members; 77 full memberships, 3 associates, and 2 comped members.
2. The Treasurer reported there was \$3,450.70 in the CVMC account. NNGA annual membership dues are yet to be paid and the March and April tournament entry fees have not been deposited as yet.
3. Junior Golf support was discussed. \$250.00 that was not donated last year and \$250.00 for this year will be presented in honor of Roger Hala at the CVMC Memorial Tournament May 30th. Dan D'Angelo will choose the two deserving junior golfers after his Meet and Greet on May 23rd.

New Business:

1. Revised CVMC Course rules have been updated and posted on the CVMC website. Nevada COVID golf course safety rules need to be clarified now that major restrictions have been lifted.
2. Several changes were made to the CVMC 2021 golf schedule including the Club Championship dates. This way, our Gross and Net Champions would well represent the CVMC at the year-end NNGA Tournament of Champions. The CVMC will fund the entry fees for our players, including a practice round prior to that event.

New Business Continued:

3. Player Code Violations were discussed. It has been noted that some golfers are reluctant to address obvious USGA golf rule violations with fellow golfers. Allowing these violations to go unchecked isn't good for our Men's Club or the spirit of the game of golf. If in doubt about a rule violation, players should discuss the issue with their foursome. If a questionable violation cannot be resolved during the course of play and the appropriate penalty stroke or strokes applied, make a notation on the score card so a tournament committee can resolve the disputed violation correctly and fairly for all players.
4. There was a question regarding the distribution of prize funds to the weekly winners' accounts. The President directed Mike Davis to look into the matter and perform a prize fund audit if needed.
